WHEN SHOULD A PATIENT BE REFERRED TO AN OCULARIST?

- Post-surgery (enucleation/evisceration)
- If they have a blind, phthisical eye
- If it has been > 6 months since they last had their eye reglazed
- If their prosthetic eye is > 5 years old
- If they are experiencing:
 - Pain
 - Dryness
 - Itching
 - Mucous Discharge
 - Drooping lids
 - Prosthesis instability (falling out/rotating)

WHAT IS THE COST FOR THESE SERVICES?

OHIP covers 75% of the costs.

The patient portion is \$30.00 for a REGLAZE, and between \$700.00-\$800.00 for a new prosthesis.

ODSP, OWP, IFHP, NIHB, WSIB, and veterans have 100% coverage.
